

What is City SC Chula Vista?

City SC Chula Vista is a 501c3 Non-Profit organization based in Chula Vista, California. We are committed to providing high value programming while keeping costs as low as possible for our membership. We are a competitive soccer club that focuses on core values such as player development and sportsmanship. City SC Chula Vista teams successfully compete within club circuits through San Diego (SoCal League). Teams participate in tournaments locally, statewide, and nationally.

How do I register my child?

How does the club registration process work?

Fill out the form and it will be added to the registration sheet that will be used during tryouts.

If I register my child, does this mean that my child is on a team?

No, your child is registered to tryout at one of the following division sessions. During tryouts, your child will be observed and evaluated.

Can my child sign up for multiple club tryouts?

Yes, your child may sign up to as many tryouts they wish.

Does my child have to be present at both tryout dates?

It is preferred that they are at both dates.

Are the coaches certified?

City SC Chula Vista coaches are USSF (US Soccer Federation) licensed.



What do Registration Fees cover?

The competitive season at City SC Chula Vista is a year-round program. Registration fees cover the costs of professional coaches, US Soccer/association fees and insurance costs, administrative fees, league fees, equipment, fields/facility usage fees, lights, referees, goalkeeper training program, select skills clinics, college recruitment services and resources. In addition to our coaching staff, we employ administrative and technical staff to oversee all club operations and provide customer service and support to all members and teams. For 2025/2026 season, registration fee is \$1,400.*

Please note: Uniform and tournament fees are NOT included in the registration fees.

What is included in your Registration Fees?

- Professional licensed coach
- Standardized curriculum and year-round coaching education program for staff
- Year-round training program
 - SoCal League teams average two training sessions a week for roughly 40 weeks out of the year with scheduled time off dispersed throughout the season (varies by team/age group/level of play)
- Pre-Season Scrimmages as organized by coach
- Spring Friendlies/Scrimmages
- 10 12 Fall League Games for SoCal League teams
 - \circ 1 formal written player evaluation from your coach
 - Access to college recruitment resources and full-time college liaisons for older players
 - Learn life lessons through sport, build lifelong friendships and lots of FUN!

Why is there a coaching fee?

City SC Chula Vista has added the coaching fee to the registration fees. City SC Chula Vista Coaches dedicate their time and effort to the players and team. They are mapping out their session plans every week.



Are uniforms included in the Registration Fee?

No, the cost of the uniforms is separate from the Registration Fee. The cost of the uniforms can range from \$300 - \$375. It includes home/away jerseys, training jersey, 2 pairs of shorts, 2 pairs of socks, training jacket, and backpack with the player's last name and jersey number.

Where are the practices held?

City SC Chula Vista teams practice in East Chula Vista area.

What days do the teams practice?

This is determined by the team's coach.

How much traveling is involved?

Some games are not played locally so there is some traveling involved.

How much to be pay for each tournament?

The fees for players depend on the cost of the tournament.

If my child is not available, do we have to pay the tournament fee?

All players playing on a team will be expected to share in the costs of tournament play whether a participant or not.

Does my child have to attend team practices?

It is required that your child attend all practices. Each player learns and develops with their teammates. It provides them fundamental skills that allows them to connect with their teammates during games.
